#### COVID

## **Applications**

The large number of applications for EuroTAB now is also good news and provides hope for the continuation of the Feldenkrais Method. This goes for both assistant trainer, trainer and training, which keeps ETAB busy. Earlier this year ETAB were surprised to find that we recently received more applications than other TABs.

There has been concern for the aging population of training staff and practitioners, even though in September 2021 a new Feldenkrais Training Program in hybrid format started at Feldenkrais Institut Wien under the

guidance of Educational Director Donna Ray. The training program is almost fully booked with a young international group of participants from 17 different countries. Among them are participants from countries like India, Finland and Bulgaria.
