#### **EU Erasmus project**

Feldenkrais is opening up for the first time to European funding to undertake internal improvement activities and increase its role and visibility in society. In March, under the Erasmus+ 2023 – the EU programme for education, training, youth and sport (<u>Home I Erasmus+ (europa.eu)</u> – , the AIIMF (the Italian Feldenkrais Association) submitted a proposal to the National Agency INAPP in partnership with the FVD (the

German Guild), IFF (International Feldenkrais Federation), and AISF (Italian Association Fibromyalgia Syndrome).

Feldenkrais4Life - Supporting the professional growth of the Feldenkrais practitioner as a key player in society for the development of health and integrated personal care is a two-year long project that aims to enhance the professional contribution that Feldenkrais Teachers can make in the evolution of society and in health and development processes for the improvement of a person's well-being and continuous learning.

The focus is to support a process of identity growth and professional recognition of the figure, accompanied by a strengthening of the vocational training capacity of the representative professional associations in an international and cross-sectoral perspective.

Results on projects approved for funding are due by summer. Let's keep our fingers crossed that this may be the first of many more projects that will help Feldenkrais become known and established in our communities!

### **ETC Website**

We are very pleased to announce that the work on ETC/ETAB's new website is progressing and the cooperation with the Israeli company Simply Smart is working smoothly.

The structure of the site is up and running and we have already started to upload material about Training Programs. The work on the digitalization of all the forms and applications though has only begun.

The main implications concerning the educational community are:

1. All the Training Programs could be found on one page and any user could search them directly through a search engine. Each program will have also a separate page where a short presentation and all the important details will be presented. This page will be linked to the program's website.

2. Advanced workshops and courses for practitioners could be announced through the ETC website. This function can facilitate the movement of people beyond national boundaries and enhance the exchange of experience.

3. All Trainers and Assistant Trainers active in the ETC region could appear with their photo and contact details. In this way, we hope to give them more visibility. The Guilds will be presented through links to their own websites.

All news would appear on the homepage and will be searchable.

We aim to publish a basic version of the new website in September which shall contain the details of all running Training Programs and of those starting soon.
