ASSESSMENT TOOL PROJECT

The introductory workshop on the Assessment Tool led by Anat Aviv Yeffet and Eitan Sarig took place successfully via Zoom on 24th and 25th April 2021, addressing participants from all the European and Israeli Feldenkrais Guilds. The National Representatives of each Guild on the EuroTAB Council (Feldenkrais European Training and Accreditation Board Council) joined forces and gave technical and facilitative support during the workshop.

The workshop was very well received, showed a real interest from the participants and it has prepared the ground for follow-up by them. The EuroTAB Council will take into account all their views and recommendations to decide on the continuity of the project or not, that may include more training seminars, in order to provide the highest quality service possible to the Feldenkrais community. Further information will be shared by the end of June or July.

NEW WEBSITE

A working group has just been settled to deal with this essential issue.

ETC and ETAB are currently joining their forces to restructure the website. The aim is to create new and interactive webpages that will meet the needs of the whole community in a more efficient and contemporary way: ETAB and the applicants (personal and trainings), ETC and its Guilds.

This will of course be a bigger project that will consume a certain amount of time and money but at the end all involved parties will greatly benefit from it. We will soon come back to you with further details and questions on needs and wishes.
